The person herein named is summoned to appear before a Public Inquiry convened under the auspices of this Tribunal and International Law on Monday, the Sixteenth Day of September in the year 2019 at 10 am in the City of Vancouver at a location to be designated.

The person herein named and duly served is considered a relevant witness in and a party to a case before this Tribunal involving the planning, engaging in, concealing and aiding and abetting Crimes against Humanity and Genocide in Canada and other offenses specified and named in the Tribunal's Public Indictment. The person named herein must appear as ordered.

BE ADVISED that failure to respond to this lawful Summons or to appear before the Tribunal may result in the immediate arrest and indictment of the named person under the terms of the Tribunal Mandate.

The proceedings of this Tribunal and Common Law Court will operate under the oversight and with the participation of the ITDC Directorate and its legal advisors, and international human rights and diplomatic observers.

This SUMMONS is a permanent Writ operating with the full force of the Law. It is issued on the First Day of July in the year 2019 under Common Law and the Law of Nations by the Directorate of The International Tribunal for the Disappeared of Canada.
